














## Wireless Network Configuration Guide Microsoft Windows 7

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	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Click on the Wireless Icon. If you do not see it, click the <i>Start</i> icon and type <i>Network and Sharing Center</i></li> <li>2. Click on <b>Open Network and Sharing Center</b></li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Click on <b>Manage Wireless Networks</b></li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. If the Massey network you want to connect to is already listed, select it and click <b>Remove</b></li> <li>5. Click <b>Add</b> to add a new network</li> </ol>

Choose <b>Manually create a network profile</b></p> <p>There are many Massey wireless networks available:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>MUStudents</b>: for students</li> <li>• <b>MUStaff</b>: for staff using Massey equipment</li> <li>• <b>MUStaffPrivateEquipment</b>: for staff using privately owned equipment</li> <li>• <b>MUEvents</b> and <b>eduroam</b> are used in special occasions</li> </ul>
	<p>7. Type <b>MUStudents</b> into the Network Name</p> <p>8. Select <b>WPA2-Enterprise</b> as the Security type</p> <p>9. Select <b>AES</b> for the Encryption type</p> <p>10. Check the box for <b>Start this connection automatically</b> (this can be left un-ticked if you wish to manually join the network each time instead)</p> <p>11. Click <b>Next</b></p>
	<p>12. Click <b>Change connection settings</b></p>

	<p>13. Select the <b>Connection</b> tab</p> <p>14. Check the <b>Connect automatically when this network is in range</b> option</p>
	<p>15. Select the <b>Security</b> tab</p> <p>16. Select <b>Microsoft Protected EAP (PEAP)</b> from the dropdown menu</p> <p>17. Click <b>Settings</b></p>
	<p>18. Select <b>Validate server certificate</b></p> <p>19. Select <b>DigiCert High Assurance EV Root CA</b>. If there are two listed, select both.</p> <p>20. Select <b>Secured password (EAP-MSCHAP v2)</b></p> <p>21. Tick <b>Enable Fast Reconnect</b></p> <p>22. Click on <b>Configure</b></p> <p>25. Click <b>OK</b></p>

	<p>23. Un-tick the checkbox (This does not apply for staff using private equipment or Massey-owned equipment)</p> <p>24. Click <b>OK</b></p> <p>25. When the previous box reappears, select <b>OK</b> where you will be returned to the <b>Wireless Network Properties</b> dialog box.</p>
	<p>26. Click the <b>Security</b> tab</p> <p>27. Click <b>Advanced settings</b></p>
	<p>28. Select <b>Specify authentication mode</b></p> <p>29. Select <b>User Authentication</b> (The box below will pop up and require your Massey credentials)</p> <p>30. Click <b>Save Credentials</b></p>
	<p>The <b>Network Authentication</b> dialog will pop up. Enter your <b>StudentID</b> and <b>Password</b> into the user name and password boxes respectively.</p> <p>Click <b>OK on all previous windows</b> and you should be connected to <b>MUsStudents</b>. Open a web browser and check that you can surf the Internet.</p>
