- **Weekdays:** Monday through Friday approximately from 9:00am to 5:00pm students commute to their host organizations for their internships.
- Weekly **mandatory** evening internship review sessions attended by students, academic coordinator, and programme staff (Fridays 5-5:45pm Scholars Lounge, Block 5).
- **Weekends:** 5:00pm on Friday through 9:00pm on Sunday is free for study or personal travel. Students leaving Wellington are required to notify their Programme Coordinator at least 24 hours in advance and provide details of itinerary in writing. Interns are expected to be fit for work during the week and not to make travel arrangements that could negatively impact their ability to contribute to their placement (e.g. late travels on Sunday evening).
