

## **TRAVEL and ACCOMMODATION FUND (0347)**

Massey University places great importance on achievements both in and out of lecture theatres. The Travel and Accommodation Fund was established to provide financial assistance to students selected to represent New Zealand at an international sporting event. Applications will be considered at any time during the year, provided they are submitted a minimum of 14 days BEFORE the event commences.

### **CRITERIA**

#### **TAF funding is available to any student who**

1. Has New Zealand citizenship or permanent residency
2. Is either an internal or distance student studying at least 60 credits at Massey University in the current academic year, and in good or better academic standing
3. Has gained FORMAL SELECTION for national representation in their chosen sport
4. Has *not* received TAF funding or the Elite World Sports Travel Award in the current academic year

### **GRANT**

- TAF funding is given to a maximum value of \$700
- Applicants may only receive TAF funding a maximum of twice across their academic study at Massey University
- Only complete applications including all required documents as outlined in the Application Checklist will be considered
- The nature of the event, travel distance and trip duration, as well as academic performance, will be taken into account when determining the outcome of TAF applications
- The selection committee reserves the right to change the allocation criteria under exceptional circumstances
- Successful applicants will be granted funds after the event, only once they have completed the post-event report (including the provision of photos)
